Important Information

To qualify for the ESTA you must have a machine readable passport

If your passport was issued on or after 26th October 2005 it must: have a digitally applied photograph.

If your passport was issued on or after 26th October 2006 it must: be a biometric passport.

Your passport will need to have an integrated chip capable of storing the biographic information from the data page. UK passports issued in the UK meet this criterion; for UK passports issued in other countries please check with that location. Other nationalities should check with their passport office.

A passport indicating that the bearer is a British Subject, British Dependent Territories Citizen, British Overseas Citizen, British National (Overseas) Citizen, or British Protected Person does not qualify for travel without a visa. A passport which states holder has Right of Abode or indefinite leave to remain in the United Kingdom does not qualify for visa free travel.

Citizens of the following countries: Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Republic of Korea & Slovakia may travel free under the ESTA Program if they meet ALL of the following requirements: Obtained travel authorisation under ESTA prior to boarding the air or sea carrier and have a valid e-passport with an electronic chip.

Visa is valid for up to 5 Years. Maximum duration of stay is up to 90 days from date of entry. ESTA can be used for both business and tourism visits.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1: Complete the forms and gather all required documents

- Please complete all forms, check to ensure every required item is included and deliver your application to Visas2 for review and submission.

Step 2: Visas2 will process the application

- Once Visas2 have received all required documentation material, complete and signed as necessary the application will be submitted at the first available date according to the consulate's availability.

Step 3: Process update and completion

- Once the visa application is approved/issued, we will advise immediately. Then proceed in collecting the passport/visa from the relevant embassy/consulate and dispatch in line with the agreed return method communicating all tracking information. Applications are usually dispatched within 24 hours of release.
