Application Form

One fully completed visa application form.

Passport

A scan copy valid UK passport info page with at least 30 days' validity from the date of arrival and at least two blank visa page

Photos

One recent passport-size colour photograph (35x45mm) on a white background, taken within the last six months and on jpeg high resolution.

Proof of Travel Arrangements

A scan copy of:

Proof of Previous Visas

Copies of any Equatorial Guinea visas issued in the past three months (if applicable)

Sufficient Funds

A scan copy of bank statement covering the last 3 months showing sufficient funds and stamped by the bank.

Travel Insurance

Scan copy of travel insurance

Minors

Each child must hold their own valid passport and an individual visa, regardless of age
o if a minor under 16 is traveling without a parent or legal guardian, a notarised letter of consent from the parent(s) or guardian is required
o the consent letter should specify the purpose of travel, full travel dates, and the name and

contact details of the designated guardian or accompanying adult
o a copy of the consenting parent's passport or UK identity document must also be provided
o a copy of the child's birth certificate or legal custody papers must be included to confirm parentage or guardianship.

Visa Information:

Visa is valid for 90 days multiple entry. Please ensure that you carry the following documents and present them at the Immigration counter

Passport: A valid passport with at least 6 months validity from the travel date of entry into Equatorial Guinea

Return flight ticket copies.

Vaccine Certificates or PCR test results if applicable.

Yellow Fever Certificate

Travel Insurance Please note: The Immigration officer might request for other additional information/documents. Please keep them readily available with you.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1: Complete the forms and gather all required documents

- Please complete all forms, check to ensure every required item is included and deliver your application to Visas2 for review and submission.

Step 2: Visas2 will process the application

- Once Visas2 have received all required documentation material, complete and signed as necessary the application will be submitted at the first available date according to the consulate's availability.

Step 3: Process update and completion

- Once the visa application is approved/issued, we will advise immediately. Then proceed in collecting the passport/visa from the relevant embassy/consulate and dispatch in line with the agreed return method communicating all tracking information. Applications are usually dispatched within 24 hours of release.

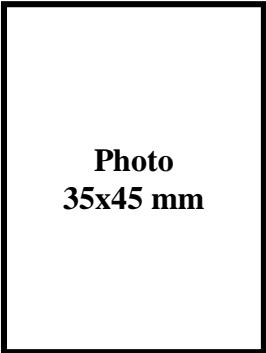
