### **Passport**

Scan copy of your passport's information page valid 6 months after the date of arrival and must have two blank pages.

### **Travel Itinerary**

Copy of your return flights.

### **Hotel Booking**

Copy of your hotel accommodation.

### **Visa Information:**

You must have an approved electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) to travel to Kenya. Processing time is minimum 4 working day process.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

### **Step 1: Complete the forms and gather all required documents**

- Please complete all forms, check to ensure every required item is included and deliver your

application to Visas2 for review and submission.

**Step 2: Visas2 will process the application**

**Step 3: Process update and completion**
